With everyone losing and beating different opposition and countbacks galore we finally had our semi-finalists. It was again relatively easy for Isabelle beating George 11-4, 11-7, 11-7, but No 2 seed Arshbir had once again a real battle with Heidi which he finally won by the score of 6-11, 13-11, 11-9, 10-12, 13-11

The final itself provided the upset of the tournament as Isabelle who had not dropped a set all day and seemed to be playing completely within herself surrendered a 2-1 lead to lose to a highly delighted and relieved Arshbir 4-11, 12-10, 2-11, 11-7, 11-9
